

Four Truths to Live By - Part 2

Truth One: **Everything I Need, Jesus Is!**

Truth Two: **Jesus always saves the best until last!**

- I. The first miracle of Christ demonstrates this truth. (John 2:7-10)
- Jesus always saves the best until last!
 - God is good. All the time. For this is His nature.
- II. This first miracle of Christ displayed His glory and the truth. (John 2:11)
- Jesus began His ministry at the wedding in Cana of Galilee and **has saved the best for us until last at the Wedding Feast of the Lamb.** (Revelation 19:6-7)
- III. The first mention of this truth includes double blessings! (Job 42:10-14)
- We should expect God to work out something good out of every situation! (Romans 28-29)
 - His 10 children doubled (Job 42:13-15)
 - He thought for sure he would die but lived to see his great grandchildren. (Job 42:16)
 - He owned double the number of animals:
 - 14,000 sheep
 - 6,000 camels
 - 2,000 oxen
 - 1,000 female donkeys
- Totals a whole lot of manure!
- With the favor of God's many blessings come the "**Duties of Responsibility**". Shovels!
- IV. The frightening mention of the disaster of the opposite of this truth. (2 Peter 2)
- Jesus always saves the best until last!**
The devil -the evil one- is just the opposite.
Satan saves the worst until last.
He wants to kill, steal, and destroy.
- God's judgement of false teachers and leaders (2 Peter 2:20)

Expect God to work in every situation for good.
