Everyday Is:

(if is not in Christ - only is)

1. **Easter - Resurrection Day!** (Romans 6:4)
 - a. Not just a one-day celebration
 - b. He is risen and alive in me everyday!
2. **Christmas - Redeemer Day!** (Luke 2:11; Job 19:25; Hebrews 13:8)
 - a. Not just a one-day celebration
 - b. He is my Redeemer and lives in me everyday!
3. The day of **Salvation - Redemption Day!** (2 Corinthians 6:2; Numbers 6:24; Psalm 121:5; John 10:28-29; 2 Samuel 22:47)
 - a. Not just the day I was born again
 - b. Everyday Jesus is my redemption!
