

Generation to Generation - Part 2

- I. What is a **generation**?
 - A generation is all the people **born and living** at about the same time.

- II. There are **five** generations alive now.
 1. **Traditionalists** or Silent Generation (1945 and before)
 2. **Baby Boomers** (1946-1964)
 3. Generation **X** (1965-1976)
 4. **Millennials** or Gen Y (1977-1995)
 5. Gen Z or iGen or Centennials or “**Screen Agers**” (1996-2015)

- III. There are **three** key impacts on shaping generations.
 1. **Parenting**
 2. **Technology**
 3. **Economics**

- IV. There are two **wrong attitudes** toward generations other than your own.
 1. The **I-Don't-Care** about the younger generation attitude. (2 Kings 20:16-19)
 2. The **I-Won't-Listen** to the older generations attitude. (1 Kings 12:1-14)

- V. There is **one** and **only one** hope for every generation (Isaiah 51:8; Ephesians 3:20, 21)
 - **This hope** doesn't happen to the entire population of a generation.
 - **This hope** must be found by each individual in each and every generation, one person at a time.
 - **This hope** is a personal faith in the Lord Jesus Christ, resulting in being born again.
