

Genuine Worship - True Worshipers

We are made to worship God and to enjoy Him forever! (John 4:23-24; Luke 19:37-40)

1. God is seeking **genuine** and **true** worshipers.
 - a. Worship is frequently **audible**.
 - b. Worship is not just making a lot of **noise**.
 - c. Worship by God's people is frequently **noisy**.

2. God created us to be **joyful** worshipers involving our **feelings**.
 - a. Worship means to **feel in the heart!**
 - b. Worship should not take place in a **feelingless** people.
 - c. Worship comes from **an inward attitude**.
 - d. Worship is not "following our feelings" but it does include our **feelings about God**.

(When the Holy Spirit is present you will find astonished wonder and heart-felt worship.)

3. God sends **revival** to His people when they worship Him with all their **hearts**.
 - a. Let's move from Palm Sunday...to...Resurrection Sunday.
 - b. Palm** Sunday worship comes out of **gratitude**.
 - c. Easter** Sunday worship is genuine worship of **God** the Father, Christ His Son, and the Holy Spirit.

4. Genuine worship begins in **private** before going **public**. (Isaiah 40:31)
 - a. Personal worship precedes public worship.
 - b. Personal worship lifts you up (soar)
 - c. Personal worship gives you strength (not weary) and stamina (not faint)
 - d. True worshipers **wait** before the Lord, especially when they **don't feel** like it!
