


## I Am Delighted To Be Here!

### The Cycle Of Victorious Living



(Psalm 37:1-8; James 1:2-5; 1 Peter 4:12-13)

1. **Commit** your ways to the Lord (verse 5)
  - **Counting On My Master In Totality!** (“Hands down”)
2. **Trust** in the Lord and rely on His faithfulness (verse 3 - “Lean on”)
  - **Truly Resting Until Something Transpires.**
  - God promises to bring something to pass (verse 5)

3. Then start **delighting** in the Lord! (verse 4)

What does it mean to delight in the Lord?

**Daily Everything Lay Into God’s Hands Triumphantly!**

(“Look up! to the Lord!”)

- A. **Rejoice always** (Philippians 4:4 - “And again I say it!”)  
Express joy! **“Be of good cheer!”** Cheer! Celebrate!  
In your present circumstances and tests, you should say, **“I-am-delighted-to-be-here!”**  
and **“I am delighted in you Lord!”**
- B. **Give thanks! Commit** your situation - circumstances - everything you can’t control! to God and **trust in Him** - and **give Him thanks** for those things. (1 Thessalonians 5:18)
- C. **Praise the Lord!** (Psalm 34:1,4; Hebrews 13:15)
- D. Tell and show God that you **love Him!**  
Delighting in the Lord is loving Him with your heart and soul.

Expressing thanks, praise, joy and rejoicing and singing is God’s love language!!!

**So, to delight in the Lord is to adore Him, worship Him, and exalt Him.**

Give God **lots of shout-outs!** He deserves them. He wants them. He rewards them!

Question 2: How does God respond to you when you delight yourself in Him?

- A. He will give you the desires of your heart! (verse 4)  
(1 Corinthians 2:9)  
**\*It is God’s desire for you** that you do not allow the tests you face to defeat you, or rob you of your joy, or cause you to fret, worry, be anxious or be full of fear.
- B. **God will put this desire into your heart to live victoriously** (1 John 5:4-5; 14)
