1. The **origins** of the Reformation.
 - a. The Reformers revolutionized how Christians interact with the Bible.
(Romans 1:17)

2. The **objectives** of the Reformation.
 - Sola Scripture - **scripture** alone (2 Timothy 3:16)
 - a. The Bible is our **final authority**.
 - b. The Bible should be made **available** to every believer.
 - c. The Bible should be read by or to **all** believers.
 - d. The Bible should be **applied** to how believers live.

3. The **outcomes** of the Reformation.
 - a. The Word of God should **nourish** the people of God.
 - b. The People of God should **read** the Word of God.
 - c. The People of God should **apply** the Word of God to how they live.
 - d. The Church of God should be **governed** by the Word of God.
 - e. **Scripture alone** for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction, in righteousness.
 - True believers are saved by **grace alone** through **faith alone** on the basis of **scripture alone** through **Jesus alone** for the **glory of God alone**.
