A. The rediscovery of the foundations of the faith.

1. **Scripture** alone (2 Timothy 3:16)
2. **Grace** alone (Ephesians 2:8-9)
3. **Faith** alone (Romans 1:17)
4. **Christ** alone (John 14:6)
5. The **Glory of God** only (Psalm 115:1; 44:8; 104:6)

B. The rediscovery of the plan of salvation.

**F** is for **Forgive**. (Ephesians 1:7a)

**A** is for **Available**. (Matthew 7:21a)

**I** is for **Impossible**. (James 2:13a; Romans 3:23)

**T** is for **Turn**. (Luke 13:3b; Romans 10:9)

**H** is for **Heaven**. (John 10:10b; 14:3)

2. The outcomes of the Reformation.
