Review: Worship - We Were Made for This

1. We were **born** to worship God and to enjoy Him forever!
2. We must be **born again** to be **true worshipers** of God.
3. We must worship God **biblically**.
4. God is seeking **genuine** and **true** worshipers.
5. God created us to be **joyful** worshipers involving our **feelings**.
6. God sends **revival** to His people when they worship Him with all their **heart**.
7. Genuine worship begins in **private** before going **public**.
